# SUMMARY OF STANDARD CONDITIONS OF CARRIAGE

DOCUMENT COURIER SERVICES and SMALL PARCEL EXPRESS SERVICES

### Application of the conditions and shipment

SGW's standard Conditions of Carriage (the "Conditions") and the price list shall apply from the time that the shipper delivers the shipment to SGW together with this cargo receipt. The shipment shall be carried by any means SGW chooses.

## Customs, Exports and Imports

SGW may perform any of the following activities on behalf of the shipper.

- a) complete, amend, or replace any document as application laws or regulations may allow, and pay any duties or other taxes required under applicable laws or regulations; or
- b) act as shipper's forwarding agent for customs and export control purposes, and act as a consignee solely for the purpose of appointing a customs broker to perform customs clearance and entry.

### **Inspections**

SGW reserves the right to open and to inspect any shipment without any notice to the shipper where SGW deems it necessary to ensure that such shipment is not in violation of any of the Conditions hereof and that SGW is able to deliver such shipment to the destination while adhering to the standard procedures and handling methods.

### Unacceptable shipment

The shipper guarantees that the shipment is acceptable and agrees that any shipment is unacceptable if:

- a) it is classified as hazardous material, as dangerous goods, as prohibited or restricted articles by IATA(International Air Transport Association), by ICAO(International Civil Aviation Organization), or by any other governmental department, or other relevant organization;
- b) no customs declaration is made when required by applicable customs regulations; or
- c) SGW declares that it cannot transport an item contained in the shipment safely or legally (such items include, but are not limited to, currency, stamps, work of art, jewelry, precious stones and metals, firearms, explosives, human remains, bearer

from negotiable instruments, perishables, illegal narcotics/drugs, animal, plants, bullions, and pornography)

### **Deliveries and Undeliveries**

No shipment can be delivered to PO boxes or postal codes. Shipments are delivered to the consignee's address given by the shipper, but not necessarily to the named consignee personally.

### SGW's Liability

SGW contracts with the shipper on the basis that SGW's liability is strictly limited to direct loss only. All other types of loss or of damage are excluded (including, but not limited to, lost profit incomes, any accrued interest, or loss of future business). SGW's liability in respect of any one shipment transported is limited to its actual cash value and shall not exceed the greater of US\$100.00(One hundred US Dollars).

### Liabilities Not Assumed

SGW is not liable for any loss or damage-arising out of circumstances beyond SGW's control. These include: any Act of God such as earthquake, cyclone, storm, flood or fog; force majeure such as war, plane crash, embargo; nay defect or characteristic of the shipment, even if known to SGW; riots, strikes, or other local disputes, hazards incident to a state of war; any act or omission by a person not employed or contracted by SGW such as a shipper, a consignee, a third party, a customs or other government officials; and magnetic damage to, or erasure of, electrical or photographic images, data or recordings.

### **Delayed Shipments**

SGW shall make every reasonable effort to pick-up and to deliver the shipment according to SGW's regular pick-up and delivery schedules, but these are not guaranteed and do not form part of the contract.

# <u>Claims</u>

Any claim brought by a shipper against SGW must be submitted in writing 30 days from the date that SGW accepted the shipment. No claim may be made against SGW after the said 30 days time limit. Claims are limited to one claim per shipment, the settlement of which will be in full and final settlement for all loss or damage in connection therewith.

### Insurance

Insurance is available covering the actual cash value in respect of loss or damage to a shipment, provided that the shipper pays the applicable insurance premium. Insurance does not cover indirect loss or damages, or loss or damages caused by delays.

### Shipper's Warranties and Liability

The shipper is liable to SGW for any loss or damage arising out of the shipper's failure to comply with any applicable laws or regulations and for any breach of the shipper's warranties and representations, which include following:

- 1) all information provided by the shipper or any of its representatives is complete and accurate;
- 2) the shipment is properly marked and addressed and packed to ensure safe transportation with ordinary care in handling; and
- 3) all applicable customs, import, export and other laws and regulations have been complied with.
